

KOPELLAH SPEEDWAY MIDWEST MODIFIED RULES

General rules that apply with other race sanctions in regards to Midwest Modified class will be allowed with Kopellah Speedway Nascar Midwest Modified's

Weight requirement

Cars must weigh a minimum of 2600 lbs with a standard transmission after race. No variances will be allowed.

Required:

Goodyear G60 & G65 or Hoosier E-Mod H40 will be allowed on all four corners. Grooving and siping will be allowed on both brands. Goodyear 8"G60 is also allowed.

Optional:

Bert, Brinn & Falcon transmissions are allowed. Ball spline couplers or magnesium components are not allowed. Cars using this transmission must weigh 2700 after race.

170 PSI compression maximum. This will be checked and there will be no tolerance over that limit. Compression will be checked by removing the spark plugs, installing compression guage, then rolling the engine over to get the compression reading.

WEIGHT MUST BE CLEARLY DISPLAYED ON DRIVERS SIDE OF THE HOOD/POST
